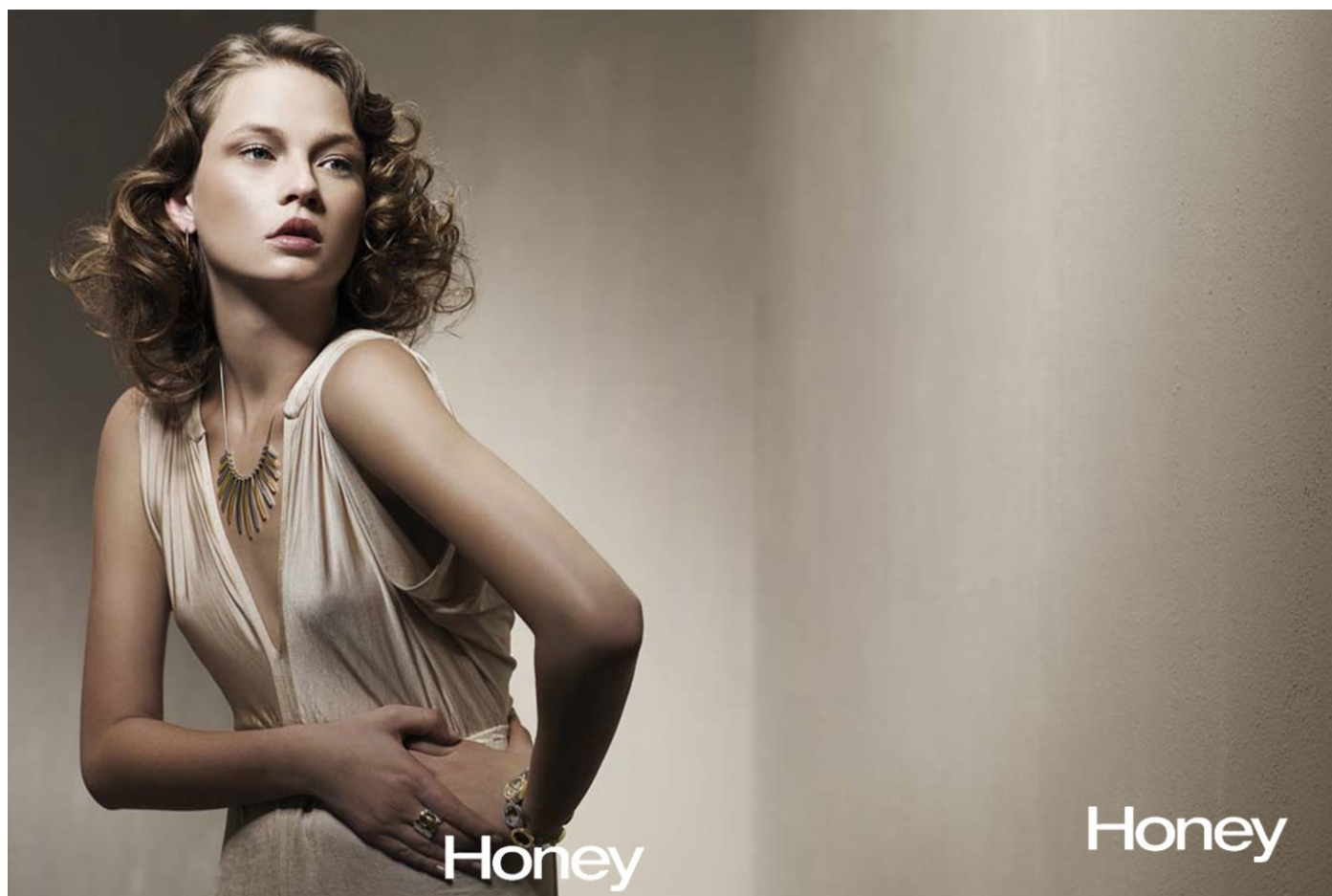


**FRANCE**

**WONDER WIG**

Sometimes skill, hairpieces and bobby pins can't disguise the truth: you're having a bad hair day. When your hair's simply not behaving, the best thing to do is sport a good wig.

Wigs work for any occasion, day or evening, and are a simple and affordable way of glamming up your look in seconds.

Keep these tips in mind when buying and storing a wig:

1. Always invest a little extra in real-hair wigs. They may cost more, but they're worth it, as you can apply heat to them for easy styling.
2. Store your wig inside out in a box of any kind.
3. If you don't use a lot of products on your wig, you'll only need to wash it once every three months. (Special wig shampoos are available from selected salons.)
4. For long-haired wigs, it's important to trim the split ends.
5. Never use oil sprays on a wig. It's simply unnecessary and can leave a heavy, dull residue.

**BEAUTIFUL BUN**  
An elegant bun is one of the easiest looks to achieve and can be dressed up or down for any occasion. All you need are a few bobby pins, a cheap hairpiece and your hands. "A short ponytail piece will work perfectly: fold it in half and pin it on. It's that easy!" says Merle. "There's room to experiment with the size of the bun, the colour and the positioning."

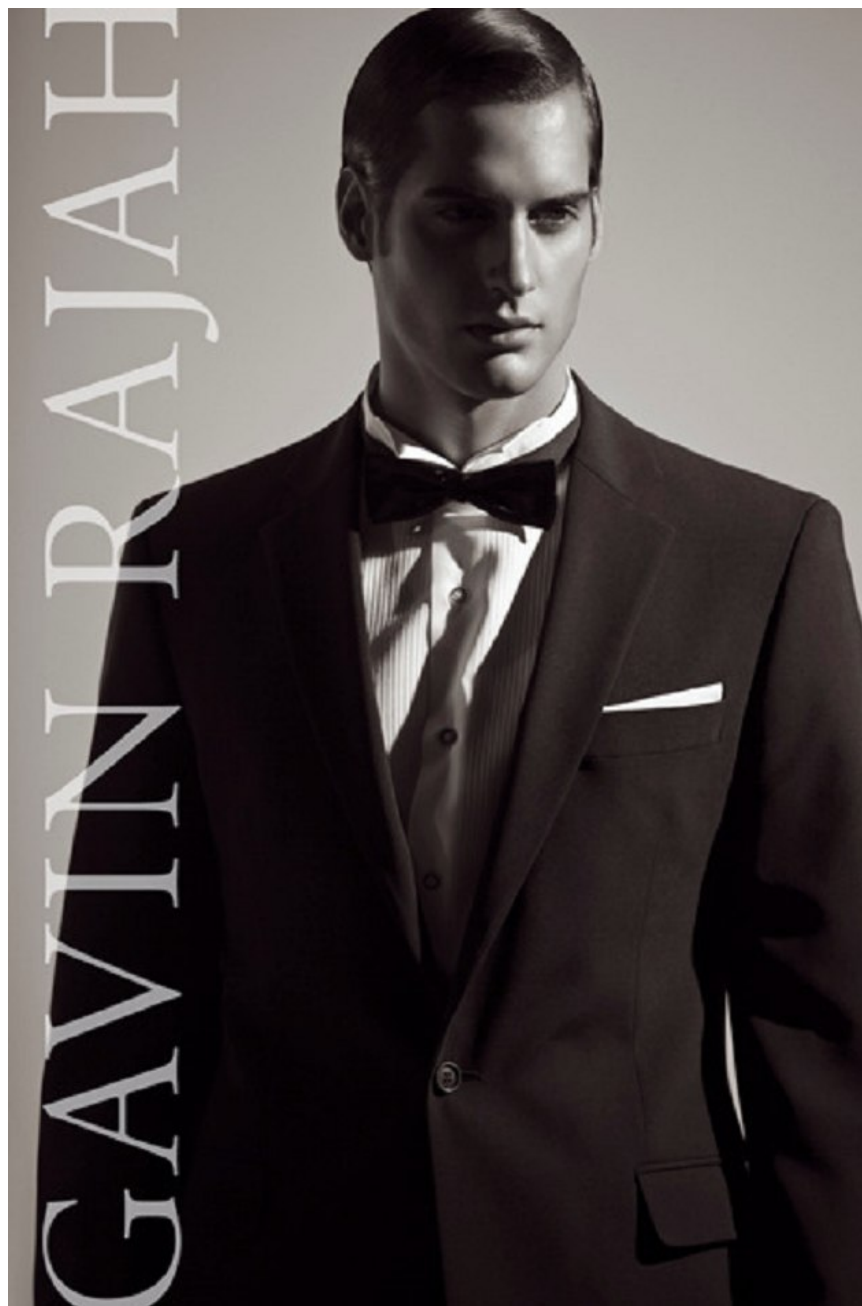




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Go big or go home

Every woman needs at least one fabulous wig that is able to completely transform her look. Here, we used a big, ringlet-curl wig that has highlighted pieces around the face. We boosted the shine with some sheen spray (ORS Olive Oil Nourishing Sheen Spray R42). Remember to store your wig on a wig stand when you're not wearing it, to ensure it keeps its shape.

TOP R7 500 ERRE

This is a surprisingly easy style to achieve, and works on medium-length and long hair. Braid the hair at the sides (cornrows would also work). Then tease the top section at the roots and spray with a strong-hold hairspray such as MoroccanOil Luminous Hairspray Extra Strong R375 to give the style some height.

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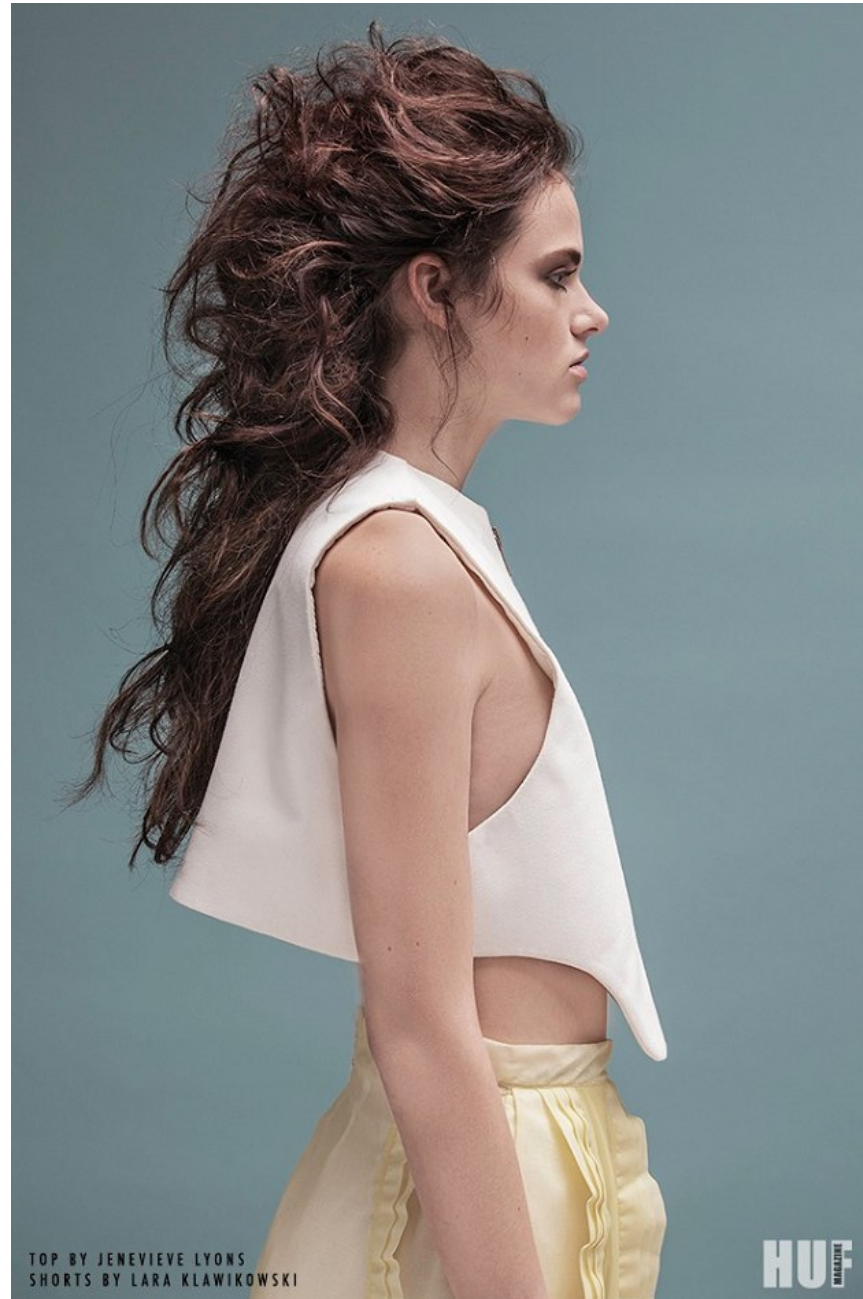




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
